Can leaves and grass clippings be burned in the Township?

Answer:

No, the Township does not allow burning of leaves or grass clippings even if you have a burning permit.

Question:

Who needs a burning permit and how can I get one?

Answer:

Anyone who wants to burn branches and/or brush needs to have a burning permit. Permits can be obtained from the Fire Department.

Question:

Are Burn Barrels legal?

Answer:

No. Holland Charter Township officially adopted a burning ordinance on May 15, 2008 and effective

Is open burning allowed year-round?

Answer:

No. Open burning requiring a burning permit is not allowed the following months: May, June, July and A
