All Holland Township Parks are open from 6:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. and are under 24-hour camera surveillance. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited at all parks. Pets are allowed, but are required to be on a leash. Please pick up after your pet. Parking is prohibited on all grassy areas.

Picnic shelters are available for use on a first come basis. Picnic shelters may not be reserved or rented.

The Howard B. Dunton Park Boat Launch payment kiosk is closed for the 2018 season. The docks for launching will still be in the water until the weather turns to winter. There is no permit needed until spring 2019 to launch. The Parks Department is hoping to have the kiosk reopen on April 1, 2019 depending on the weather.

Sec. 20-5. Molesting animals. It shall be unlawful for any unauthorized person to chase, trap, injure, molest, kill, annoy or remove any animal, either wild or domestic, on land, in the air or in the water in any park. (Comp. Ords. 1987, § 20.252(d); Code 1991, § 9-5)
