Bicycle Safety Tips

The Ottawa County Sheriff's Office wants to remind residents of Ottawa County to stay safe while biking by following some basic rules.

- 1. Always wear an approved safety helmet.
- 2. Utilize the bike paths when ever possible.
- 3. Only one rider per bike unless equipped with 2 or more seats.
- 4. If riding on the road, ride on the right side with traffic and follow all of the traffic laws.
- 5. Use hand signals.
- 6. Wear highly visible clothing.
- 7. If riding under low light conditions or darkness, use a headlight and rear flashing red light.
- 8. Watch for vehicles backing out of driveways and when crossing intersections. (Cars don't always see you).

Why Register your Bike?

The Ottawa County Sheriff's Office responds to numerous reports of bicycles that are stolen each year, however very few bikes are returned because of a lack of identifying information about the stolen bicycle including the make, model and serial number.

The Ottawa County Sheriff's Office also recovers a large number of bicycles each year that never get returned because the owners never report the bicycle as stolen. Please report all bikes stolen as soon as possible to your local police agency.

In addition to registering your bike, the Ottawa County Sheriff's Office recommends that you purchase and use a quality bike lock.



HOW TO REGISTER

You may bring in the completed registration form to either the Holland or Park Township Offices during normal business hours or you may mail the form in to the address listed on the back of the form.

If you need assistance in locating the serial number or other information required to register your bike, please contact the Ottawa County Sheriff's Office Community Policing Unit.
