To Whom It May Concern:

The Holland Charter Township Building Inspector has advised me that based upon the anticipated (cold) temperatures during the time the concrete is curing, the weather is not currently suitable for placing concrete. I acknowledge that by placing concrete on the date and address noted above, I am doing so at my own risk and that I agree to obtain compressive strength tests of the concrete by an approved testing agency, at my own expense, before the foundation will be approved.

The only test currently accepted by Holland Charter Township for verifying compressive strength is the Windsor Probe test. Approval to backfill will not be granted until a satisfactory test report has been provided to the building department.

I further acknowledge that I will be responsible for removing all concrete, including the cost for doing so, that fails to pass the compressive strength test. I also understand that this letter will be part of the permanent file for this property, and as such, is a public record.
