## Regular Meeting April 6, 2023

Mr. Nienhuis reviewed the consent agenda.

A motion was made by Mr. TeSlaa, supported by Ms. Molotky, to approve the consent agenda including communications, operational reports (Sheriff's Department Report for February and Building Department Report for March), bills and financial transactions for March, and the minutes of the Board meeting held on March 16, 2023.

The next item was the consideration of a renewal of a METRO Act Right-of-Way Permit with KEPS Technologies, Inc. (dba ACD.net). Mr. Bulthuis reviewed the extension and stated the recommendation is that the Board approve extending ACD.net's ROW permit to March 28, 2028 and authorize the Manager to execute the permit extension on the Township's behalf.

Ms. Molotky introduced and the Board had a first reading on one proposed rezoning ordinance – 9754 Perry Street (70-16-25-200-021) – AG Agricultural to R-1 Low Density Residential.

Board members were invited to visit the new vehicles in the parking lot. Mr. Nienhuis shared the Board's support and appreciation of the fire department.
