

HOLLAND CHARTER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Regular Meeting
February 19, 2026

The Supervisor called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Present: Supervisor Russ TeSlaa, Clerk Michael Dalman, Treasurer Vince Bush, and Trustees Elliott Church, Dave DeYoung and Gretchen Molotky. Also present was Township Manager Steve Bulthuis.

Absent: Trustee Terry Nienhuis

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and Mr. TeSlaa gave the invocation.

Citizen's Comments: Mr. Steven Willard was present to address the Board on his concerns regarding a noise concern.

County Commissioners Jacob Bonnema and Jordan Jorritsma were present to introduce new County Administrators Patrick Waterman and Brian Dissette. Both spoke of their backgrounds and answered questions from the Board.

Mr. TeSlaa reviewed the consent agenda.

26-18 A motion was made by Mr. Bush, supported by Ms. Molotky, to approve the consent agenda including communications (none), operational reports (Sheriff's Department Report for January – Lieutenant Knott and Fire Department Report for January – Chief Tibbetts), and the minutes of the Board meeting held on February 5, 2026.

Next were various Ottawa County Road Commission project estimates for street maintenance and improvements. The estimates include 2.9 miles of various subdivision streets for \$759,338.10. The Board also reviewed two maintenance project estimates from the Ottawa County Road Commission. The first was a project estimate with the Ottawa County Road Commission for chloride application for dust control on various streets. The estimated cost for applications is \$1700.00/application with a \$100 administration fee. The Board also considered a project estimate with the Ottawa County Road Commission for roadside mowing and trimming on those portions of US-31 & BL-196 within the Township at a cost of \$10,000.00/cycle of mowing and trimming with a \$500.00 administration fee.

26-19 Moved by Mr. Dalman and supported by Ms. Molotky to approve the OCRC estimate for 2026 street resurfacing projects of subdivision streets.

26-20 Moved by Mr. Church and supported by Mr. Bush to approve the project estimate for 2026 roadside mowing/trimming (US-31 & BL-196) and seek up to three mowings from the County.

26-21 Moved by Ms. Molotky and supported by Mr. Bush to approve the OCRC estimate for 2026 chloride application for dust control.
