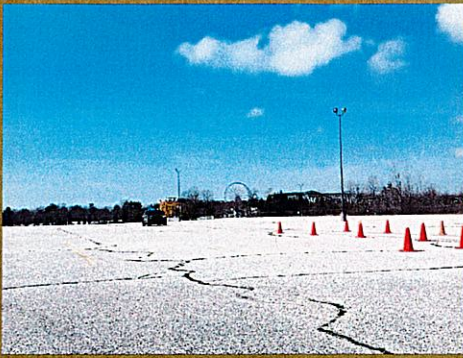

This month was a busy and productive one for the Ottawa County Sheriff's Office. Deputies sharpened their skills behind the wheel through a hands-on Defensive Driving obstacle course, while Clerks from the Administrative Clerks Office brought their children in for a special tour of the Sheriff's Office, a fun and memorable experience for everyone involved. Rounding out the month was our Marine Patrol Academy, a week-long certification program that brought agencies from across the state together for both classroom instruction and hands-on experience out on the water.





One of the highlights of the month was our Defensive Driving Training, where deputies took part in a hands-on obstacle course designed to sharpen their skills behind the wheel and prepare them for defensive driving situations in the field. The training provided a valuable opportunity for deputies to test and strengthen their capabilities in a controlled and structured environment.

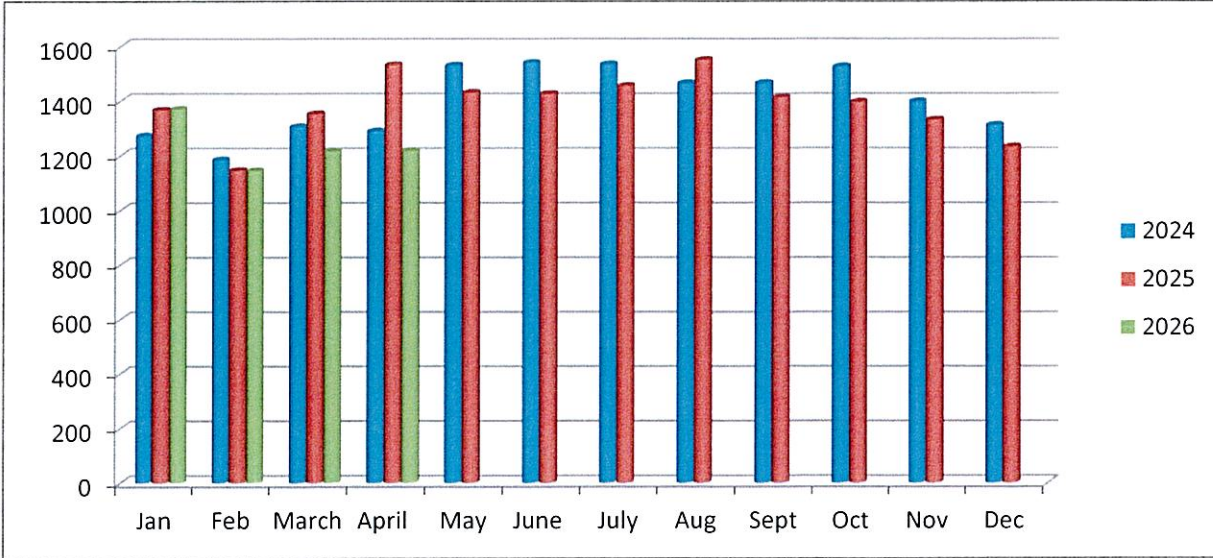
26 Individuals earned awards for their outstanding service during the 100 car pileup that occurred on I-196.



Deputy Evan Potter based out of Holland Township earned the Ottawa County Customer Service Award for his quick action and precision while safely delivering a baby in the field.

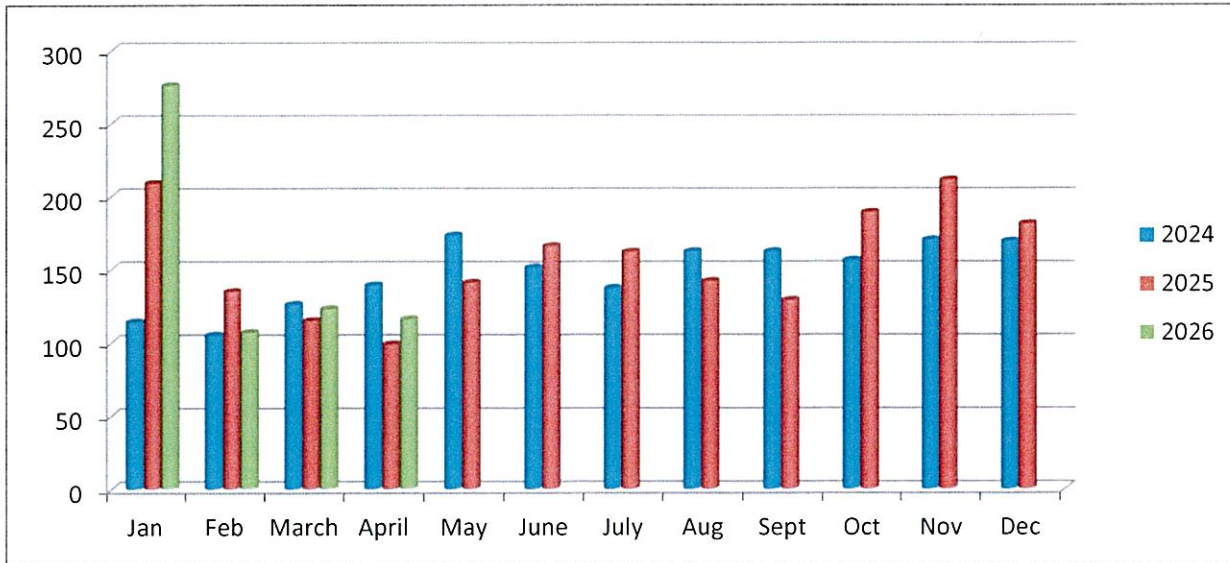

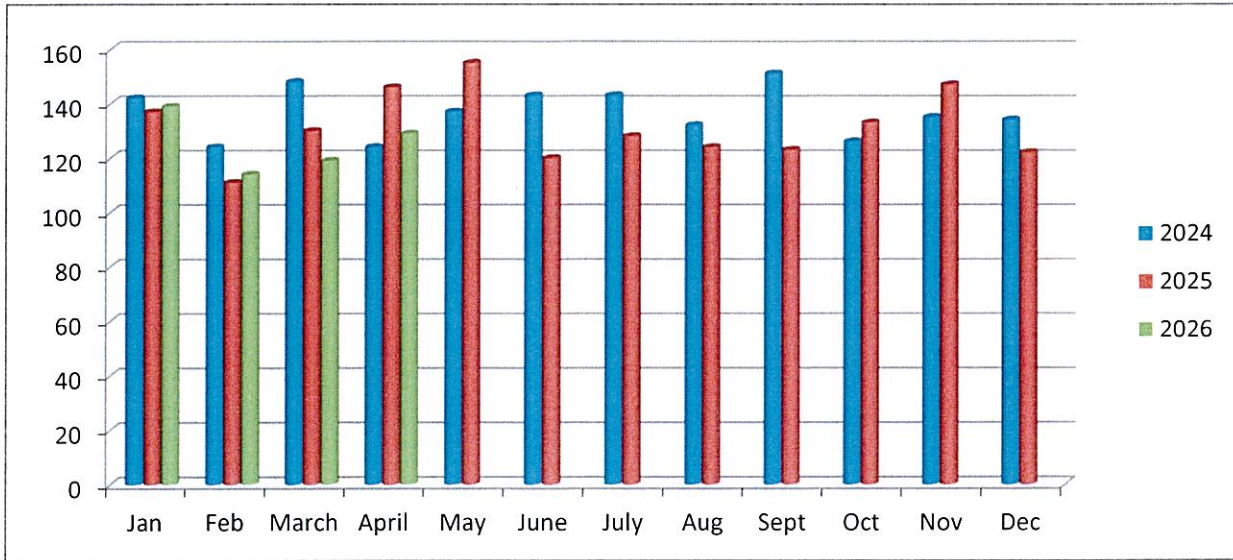

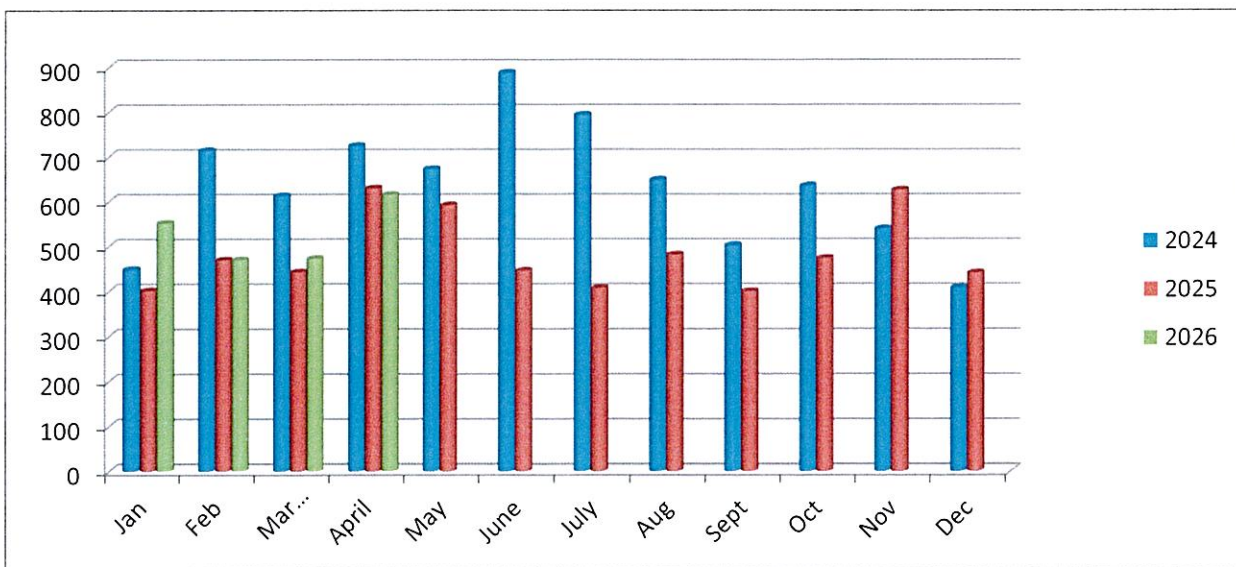
