RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Chapter 9 of the Holland Charter Township Code provides that all keeping of residential chickens fees shall be subject to such fees as are established by resolution of the Township Board; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board desires to establish a schedule of fees for the keeping of residential chickens in the Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) The Township Board establishes the following schedule of fees for the keeping of residential chickens pursuant to Chapter 9 of the Holland Charter Township Code.

Keeping of Residential Chickens Fees

The following fees shall be applicable pursuant to Chapter 9 of the Holland Charter Township Code.

Application Fee

Application for the Keeping of Residential Chickens	\$150
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Inspection Fees

Additional Inspection	\$100
Missed Inspection	\$100
Denied Entry	\$50
Complaint Investigation Resulting in a Violation	\$50

Other Administrative Fees / Penalties

Late Charge for Unpaid Invoices Exceeding 30 days	\$50
Penalty for Suspended Permit	\$150

- 2) All terms used in this resolution that are defined in the Zoning Ordinance shall have the same meaning as is specified therein.
- 3) The above fee schedule revisions shall take effect for all applications submitted after _____, 2026 and shall remain in effect until further amended or revoked by resolution of the Township Board.
- 4) Any other fee resolutions in conflict are revoked effective _____, 2026, to the extent inconsistent with this Resolution.
