The Supervisor called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and Mr. Dalman gave the invocation.

Citizens' Comments: Mr. Steven Willard was present to give thanks to our code enforcement officer, Jenny Hamzik. He also updated us on his code violation reporting for the past year.

Mr. Justin Roebuck, County Clerk, was present to express appreciation for Clerk Dalman and his work as Township Clerk.

Mr. TeSlaa reviewed the consent agenda.

26-78 A motion was made by Mr. Nienhuis, supported by Mr. Bush, to appoint Daniele Dykens as Township Clerk following Mr. Dalman's resignation.

The next agenda item was the consideration of the reappointment of Margo Walters to the MAX Transportation Authority Board.

26-79 A motion was made by Ms. Molotky, supported by Mr. Dalman, to reappoint Margo Walters to the MAX Transportation Authority Board for a three-year term ending June 15, 2029.
